SilverLakes is pleased to announce the re-opening of our community amenities.

On April 19, 2021, Broward County revised their Emergency Orders, specifically removing restrictions that affected the use of community pools and common elements.

The Board is aware of the anticipation to have the pool and other amenities re-opened for resident use, and we are thankful that the County has now lifted the restrictions previously preventing this.

A safe and effective reopening is a top priority to the Association. As such your Board has directed management to prepare the outdoor amenities for a reopening effective Saturday May 8th.

We remind all residents that access to the pool is now via a digital access platform. Access to the community pool is available through your cell phone or other bluetooth enabled smart device. Please ensure you have registered and activated your community pool access app.

Access to the pool and all private SilverLakes amenities is limited to SilverLakes residents, and guests, only. Tenants must have an approved lease on file to obtain amenity access.

If you have not already obtained the pool access application, please reach out to support@pinespropertymanagement.com with your name and address to commence the process.

As a final note, while the restrictions have been eased, our cities, state and country are still fighting the Covid pandemic. We are thankful that our community amenities will be enjoyed by our residents again very soon.
